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Report on the Firm's System of Quality Control

As part of our peer review, we considered reviews by regulatory agencies as communicated by the firm, if applicable, in determining the nature and extent of our procedures.

Opinion

In our opinion, the system of quality control for the accounting and auditing practice of Arnold, Behrens, Nesbit, Gray P.C. in effect for the year ended June 30, 2017, has been suitably designed and complied with to provide the firm with reasonable assurance of performing and reporting in conformity with applicable professional standards in all material respects.
